NORTH CHARLESTON, SC

March 20, 2001

2 Alarms

Ashley Phosphate Road

Eleven companies operated at an attic fire in a one-story brick building.

FAYETTEVILLE, NC

March 24, 2001

2 Alarms

Bubbletree Court

Heavy damage to two units of an 18-unit apartment complex.

HOLLY HILL, SC

March 24, 2001

4 Alarms

State Street

Commercial building fire extended to others in the downtown area.

GREENSBORO, NC

March 25, 2001

2 Alarms

Deer Track Lane

Large two-story house located well off the road forced the use of drop tanks and long hose lays.

WOODRUFF, SC

March 26, 2001

4 Alarms

Peachtree Street

Extensive mutual aid required for a fire in a large mill complex. The fire in the mammoth four-story brick structure required the evacuation of nearby homes. Large rekindle the following day resulted in the loss of two warehouses.

LONGRIDGE FD, BERKELEY COUNTY, SC

March 27, 2001

2 Alarms

Longridge Road

Two fully involved houses. The water point was 13 miles away.

DURHAM, NC

April 1, 2001

2 Alarms

West Parrish Street

Defensive operations required at a turn of the century building in downtown.

CHARLOTTE, NC

April 3, 2001

3 Alarms

Hawthorne Lane

Crews initially responding to a fire alarm found large bales of cotton and machinery on fire at a manufacturing warehouse.

RALEIGH, NC

April 8, 2001

2 Alarms

Brent Road

Heavy fire through the roof of a two-story duplex required ladder pipe operations.

YOUNGSVILLE, NC

April 11, 2001

2 Alarms

Rolling Acres Drive

A vehicle fire extended to a liquid propane tank, mobile home and a house.

MYRTLE GROVE FD, NEW HANOVER COUNTY, NC

April 12, 2001

2 Alarms

Tyner Road

Six mutual aid departments required for fire involving a Middle School.

RALEIGH, NC

April 13, 2001

2 Alarms

Trawick Road

Fire in a large occupied metal skating rink.

HIGH POINT, NC

April 19, 2001

2 Alarms

Feldstar Road

Gas explosion in an apartment complex severely burned one civilian, several firefighters injured.

BAY LEAF FD, WAKE COUNTY, NC

April 20, 2001

2 Alarms

Chatsworth Lane

Mutual aid required from five departments for a large house and adjacent woods fire.

CLAYTON, NC

April 20, 2001

3 Alarms

Main Street

Two ladder pipes operated in the downtown area on brick commercial buildings involving three businesses.

VANDER FD, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, NC

April 23, 2001

2 Alarms

Cedar Creek Road

Fully involved gas/convenience/grocery store.

SPRING HOPE, NC

April 24, 2001

3 Alarms

NC Highway 581
Explosions and fire at a trucking company. Two water points utilized.

CHARLOTTE, NC

April 27, 2001
2 Alarms
Providence Creek Lane
Heavy fire conditions in a 5,000 square foot occupied dwelling.

RALEIGH, NC

April 30, 2001
2 Alarms
Snipe Creek Lane
Second Alarm on arrival for a three-story apartment building with heavy fire showing.

CHARLOTTE, NC

May 3, 2001
2 Alarms
Caldwell Street
Fire in a third floor apartment of a ten-story apartment building. Evacuation of elderly residents.

DURHAM HIGHWAY FD, WAKE COUNTY, NC

May 4, 2001
2 Alarms
Glenlivet Way
Originally dispatched as a fire alarm, companies found a working fire in a two-story dwelling. One male resident fatal.

BAY LEAF FD, WAKE COUNTY, NC

May 6, 2001
2 Alarms
Wyndfield Circle
Tanker operations required for a large two-story dwelling fire.

GASTONIA, NC

May 11, 2001
Union Street
One firefighter injured while fighting a fire in a restaurant.

CHARLESTON, SC

May 19, 2001
2 Alarms
North Market Street
Four-story building with restaurant on ground floor. Kitchen fire with vertical extension.

SPRING HOPE, NC

May 25, 2001
2 Alarms
North Pine Street
Seven departments required for a smokey blaze at conveyor belt plant.

DURHAM HIGHWAY FD, WAKE COUNTY, NC

May 30, 2001
Multiple Fatal Accident
Interstate 540
County and city companies responded to a median cross-over collision that killed four teenagers.
