3 Alarms

Capital Blvd

Two ladder pipes were used to control an arson fire at a large interconnected abandoned hotel complex.

2 Alarms

Carlton Road

Bad hydrants hampered operations at a duplex fire. One civilian sent to the burn center.

CORNELIUS, NC

Huntersville-Concord Road

Four fire departments used to control a fire in a very large outdoor greenhouse.

Castle Rock Road

A fire at an industrial facility sent over thirty firefighters to the hospital for chemical burns and decontamination.

Six engines and three quints used to control a fire in an auditorium.

Fully involved carpet business. Two tower ladders up and flowing.

Heavy fire through the roof of a two story wood frame.

Shadow Pond Lane  
A 4,200 square foot house was struck by lightning.

Heavy smoke conditions in a downtown commercial building.

Severe water problems hampered operations at a large remote warehouse. Extensive mutual aid.
